





Interior sash and case windows should be painted regularly to prevent deterioration of the timber and to improve their appearance. One of the main problems interior windows face is condensation. This can cause black mould (which is a serious health hazard) and the wood to rot.

We offer a full interior sash and case painting and refurbishment service that protects your windows against condensation & wood rot. Our interior sash & case refurbishment and paint service consists of preparing the original paint surfaces, treating any black mould, treating any rotted wood. The windows are then painted with PERMA-WHITE INTERIOR.

PERMA-WHITE INTERIOR stays fresher longer than normal conventional interior paints.

Perma-White is a proven solution to the problem of mould and mildew build up on interior windows. Ideal for kitchens, bathrooms & bedrooms. The most common type of mould, black mould, actually thrives on ordinary paint film; especially in environments with high levels of condensation and humidity.

A typical interior sash window refurbishment and painting will involve

- poor and flaking paint is removed
- treat any black mould
- treat any rotted wood
- all areas are prepared by sanding to a smooth finish
- apply 1 coat of primer to bare wood
- apply 2 coats of PERMA-WHITE INTERIOR
- · re-rope windows if specified
- replacing all the ironmongery if specified
- Install insurance compliance security locks if specified
